# STUDENT MINISTRY: GRADES 7-12



## SUNDAY MORNING LIFEGROUPS

Our Sunday LifeGroup leaders operate in three-person squads, working together to cover the field every week. Leaders rotate the start, taking turns leading the Bible study, while the whole team stays active in man-to-man coverage—praying for students, following up, and building Hall of Fame relationships.

Our roster is typically split by grade and gender across both hours, but we've got a couple of utility groups to ensure no one is left on the sidelines:

- **9:15 am:** One Middle School co-ed group.
- **11:00 am:** One High School co-ed group.

We provide the playbook (curriculum) and the head coaching you need to effectively lead your group to a win. **Ready to get in the game?**

## WEDNESDAY LIFEGROUPS

Our Wednesday night service for 7th–12th grade students is called **The House**. The House is the “front door” of our student ministry—the ultimate home field for 7th–12th graders. We hit the floor with high-energy worship, sermons that move the chains, and a focus on building a Christ-centered community. We're looking for Team Leaders to join our coaching staff to build relationships with students, model behavior, serve as an example of how to worship King Jesus in a group setting, and serve as small-group coaches for our student leaders who serve as small-group discussion leaders. Typical nights include hangout time from 6:00 pm–6:30 pm; service from 6:30 pm–7:30 pm, and small groups from 7:30 pm–8:00 pm.

Every other week, we also have post-service activities like House Parties and WAC (Wednesday After Church) where we need adult help from 8:00 pm–9:00 pm.

We aim to be a student-led, adult-guided ministry where our students lead in the work of ministry with adults guiding them along the way.*

**Entry-Level Serving Opportunities:** For adults who want to serve in student ministry but are unable to make a consistent commitment for the year, we need adults willing to help us with events like Fall Kickoff, State Fair Night, our House Christmas Party, Victory Weekend, Camp, Mission Trips, and more. Also, we aim to have weekly Sunday and Wednesday night student-greeting teams that need an adult to serve as a guide. We aim to have adults rotate as leaders of our student welcome teams monthly.



## FIRST FRIENDS SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY



The First Friends Ministry is all about ensuring every player has the support they need to succeed. Some of our First Friends participants are part of our Inclusion Squad, where they take the field in their age-appropriate classes with a dedicated Buddy acting as their personal coach. Other participants stay in a fully equipped classroom where their coaches help them follow a schedule for Bible lessons, gross motor play, and sensory activities.



# LOCAL MISSIONS



## **FORNEY ISD HYGIENE KITS: 70 ADULT DELIVERY TEAM MEMBERS**

Delivery teams will deliver hygiene kits to students' homes, working in pairs, for 2–4 hours per month on Thursdays, with AM or PM pickup times available. Training provided.

## **MINISTRY TO STUDENT PARENTS: 30 ADULTS**

Teams of two deliver baby supplies, share the gospel, and mentor/encourage students who have newborn babies.

## **MESQUITE ISD MINISTRY STUDENT TUTORS: 20 TUTORS**

People who can tutor Middle School and High School students in math and English on Wednesdays throughout the school year from 4:00 – 5:30 pm.

## **MESQUITE ISD MINISTRY SHEPHERDS: 10 ADULTS**

Shepherds will hang out with youth while at FBCF from 5:00 – 8:00 pm on Wednesdays throughout the school year.

## **MESQUITE ISD MINISTRY BUS DRIVERS: 6 COMMERCIALY LICENSED BUS DRIVERS**

Drivers leave mid-afternoon on Wednesdays to pick up the kids from various MISD Schools. Background Check Required.

## **MAKING OUR CHURCH KNOWN IN THE COMMUNITY INITIATIVE: 40 ADULTS**

Attend community activities to share information about FBCF. This includes passing out church fliers, food, water, and primarily evangelizing. Dates and times will vary.

## **FBC FORNEY FOOD DISTRIBUTION: 40 ADULTS**
